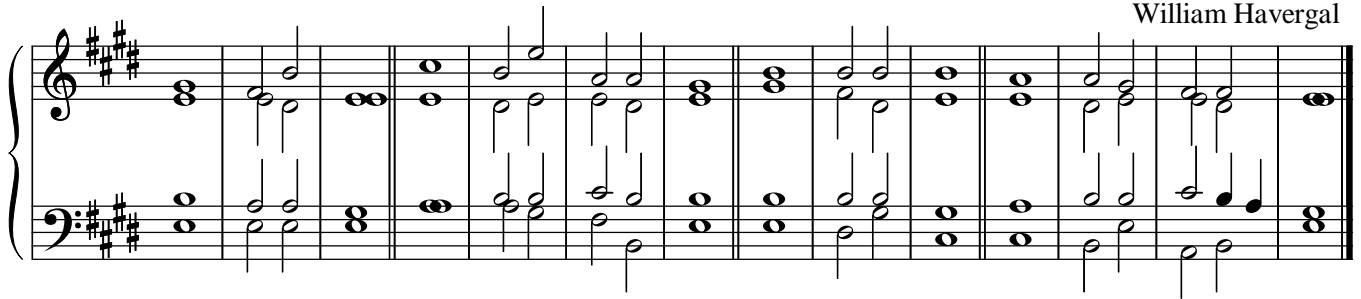


Psalm 160
